Minutes of September 22, 2020

Record of Proceedings

Due to Covid-19 this regularly scheduled meeting of the Washington Township Board of Trustees was conducted remotely via http://global.gotomeeting.com/join/147176629 from the Washington Township Administration Building, 6200 Eiterman Road, Dublin, Ohio, on September 22, 2020, at 6:00 p.m. Meeting was called to order by Ms. Denise Franz King, Chair.

Ms. King reviewed the process of the remote meeting.

Roll call – Ms. Denise Franz King, Chair – Present

Mr. Jan Rozanski, Vice Chair - Present

Mr. Charles Kranstuber, Trustee – Present

Amlin Area Improvements:

Ms. King stated, after the Board of Trustees virtual meeting held on August 11, and after receiving written comments from several of the Amlin Residents prior to the presentation done by EMH&T, on August 15, 2020, at the Board of Trustees' Strategic Planning meeting, the Board adopted the following prioritization for the improvements of the Amlin Area:

- o Phase I Stormwater Management
 - Prioritizing the Engineering cost estimates, design and construction for stormwater improvements with our community partners Franklin County and the City of Dublin.
- o Phase II sidewalks and streetscaping beautifications along Rings Road
 - The Board Elected to move forward with the design of sidewalks north and south side of Rings Road, east of the railroad tracks to Churchman Road roundabout. The sidewalks will be the narrowest allowed in compliance with the ADA. The Board also asked the consultants to study the feasibility of adding a sidewalk or shared use path on the north side of Rings Road, west of the railroad track to Cosgray Road.
- Phase III Amlin Alleys
 - After evaluating comments and feedback from the residents the Board has elected to leave all alley access points that currently exists, there will be no closed alleys. Grading, asphalt and stormwater runoff will be improved to the existing Township Right of Way Alleys.

Ms. King stated with this statement she felt this might put people at ease.

EMH&T:

Mr. Mike Brehm continued with the update of the project and he included the cost estimates associated with the different phases of this project. Some of these costs will be contributed to by the County or the City, along with grants or possible loans. Mr. Richter stated the City of Dublin has amended their Capital Improvement Plans to include some of these issues with the drainage on Cosgray and Rings Road. There was further discussion held regarding the project to clarify the details. Next steps will be to apply for grants to fund this projects. Deadline for application of grant is September 30, 2020, with award of grant by December 31, 2020, receiving grant somewhere in the spring of 2021 and start of constructions possibly next summer.

Motion by Mr. Kranstuber, seconded by Ms. King, to propose moving forward with the detail drawings as presented for the Amlin Alleyways, to include stormwater drainage, to resolve this problem to the east/west alleyways, to reconstruct and to include the north/south alleyway, budget for tar and chip sealant, and to include cosmetic improvements too. The Trustees also instructed EMH&T not to do anymore research regarding Cosgray Road stormwater drainage, since this is in the City of Dublin's jurisdiction. Motion passed.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND / OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, Washington Township is planning to make capital improvements to Rings Road, Frieszell Avenue, First Avenue, Second Avenue and Third Avenue, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Washington Township, Franklin, Delaware, and Union Counties, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: The Township Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

SECTION 2. The Township Administrator is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.
