

# Community Gardening

The Washington Township Community Garden is located at the corner of Cosgray Rd. and Rings Rd. at Amlin Crossing Park. Plots are 12' x 14'. You don't need experience, just a willingness to learn and maintain your garden for the duration of the growing season. Plots will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, with priority given to returning gardeners. A volunteer committee oversees the day-to-day operations of the garden.

**To be a part of the community garden, gardeners should plan to:**

- Visit the garden two to three times a week during the growing season.
- Attend scheduled meetings.
- Harvest produce on a regular basis.

**Please read the Community Garden Guidelines before registering, as compliance with these guidelines is a requirement for participation in this program.
